Purposes

The Infant School helps to promote the integral formation of the child's personality, seen as an active subject.

It pursues the development of:

identity: living peacefully, feeling well, feeling secure, learning to know own's identity and being recognized as a unique and non-repeatable person;

autonomy: trusting oneself and others, expressing feelings, emotions and opinions, participating, making choices and taking conscious behaviours

competence: playing, moving, manipulating, being curious, asking, reflecting, understanding, representing, imagining.

citizenship: laying the groundwork for ethically oriented behaviour, respectful of others, of the environment and of nature.

Age of access: three years

School time



There are 6 sections of homogeneous age, and 1 non-homogeneous for five days a week, from Monday to Friday from 8.35am to 4.35pm for a total of 40 hours per week; for families who request it, the reduced time is provided, from 8.35am to 1.35pm, from Monday to Friday for a total of 25 hours per week.

The curriculum

The activities concern the following fields of experience:

The self and the other: development of the sense of personal identity; exploration and construction of rules of behaviour and of relationship in respect of differences.

Body and movement: development of body and motion skills, considering the body as an instrument of exploration, expression and communication,

Images, sounds, colours: expressiveness, non-verbal, pictorial, plastic, manipulative, sonorous-musical, audio-visual, dramatic-theatrical and mass-media languages.

Speeches and words: language in all its functions and forms or as means of communication, expression, exploration and knowledge.

Knowledge of the world: knowledge of reality through exploration, reflection, research activity. It is divided into two areas "objects, phenomena, living beings" and "number and space".

Purposes

At the end of the course the student must have acquired the following skills:

- Communicate your thinking, your experience, your knowledge, in different contexts and situations, in a simple, clear and coherent way;

- Understanding verbal and non-verbal messages, obtaining even non-explicit information;

- Knowing how to properly use the different codes (verbal, written, gestural, musical, numerical, graphic);

- Observe, describe, analyze elements, facts, phenomena;

- Autonomously use the techniques and tools of the various disciplines;

- Knowing the essential contents of the various disciplines and knowing how to reuse them even in different problematic situations;

- Use your knowledge to make informed choices;

Respect and adopt ethically acceptable behaviour in different social contexts.

School time



30 hours of curriculum (with an option between Catholic religious Ed. or alternative subject). The curricular didactic activity provides a time schedule divided into five days a week, from Monday to Friday, of six hours each from 8.00 to 14.00.

The ringing of the entrance bell, to guarantee the punctual start of the lessons, is given at 7.55; the students enter the school building one class at a time, starting from the first classes students, to then be taken over by the teacher of the first hour who takes them to the classroom, where the teaching activity begins.

The timetable includes **two morning intervals**, the former **from 9.55 am to 10.05 am**; the latter **from 11.55 to 12.05**.
